Valley Crest-

The Hole in White system has been implemented. The teeing areas are in great shape. The overseeding and composting, along with the wet weather helped. The water fountains have been fixed, made vandal proof. Leaf removal and cleanup was done in January. Mulching was done around the club house. The Modesto Memorial Tree Foundation planted a tree on the 14th fairway. The 17th Tee to be looked at due to recent injury issues, VC will work with the city to address issues. The #1 tee project has been put off due to weather conditions, no start date yet. VC is working with the city on the current maintenance budget issues. But with the reduced maintenance services, capitol projects have been postponed. VC is asking the MGC to solicit the city on needed course projects. Ed Solansky brought up the cost effectiveness of an onsite turf sod nursery. VC reports they are looking to setup an area at Creekside, to service all city properties.

Minutes of Jan5th meeting – presented, read and approved.

Treasurers Report –

Presented, read and approved. NCGA was paid, \$7,146 for 2010 memberships. An additional \$1525 was taken in Jan for renewals and new memberships.

Membership Report – currently there are 228 members, 5 Dryden extras.

Golf Committee – Nothing new to report, the next meeting is 2/3. Most of the issues were discussed at the 1/2/10 meeting held here at Dryden GC. This event was well attended and it was an eye opening experience for all city officials present.

Tournament report –

The Jan 13 tournament had 55 players, the payout was \$1080 and cost the club \$162. The Jan 23 tournament had 32 players, the payout was \$675 and cost the club \$142.50.

Old Business- The suggested changes to the by-laws were presented to the board. Ed ask everybody to review these suggest changes and review with the current by-laws. Larry Lay made a motion to buy George Price a new battery for his laptop computer, with he uses for our tournaments. The motion was approved. Gary also authorized the purchase of a flashdrive to save electronically the minutes of our meetings. And the club will be sending out thank you cards to the city officials for coming out to Dryden Park and meeting with the membership. They will also be invited to attend a MGC meeting and play in club tournament.
